William Driver, 29, labour, born Finningham Suffolk

Elizabeth Driver, wife, 33, born Brading

John J Driver, son, 3, born Upminster Essex

William J Driver, son, 9mo, born St Helens

William married his first wife, Elizabeth Walker, 11 May 1847 in Clapham, Surrey. Their first child was born in Upminster, Essex.

It is not known why they left the Isle of Wight where they had obviously met.

Elizabeth died of cockle poisoning, 13 July 1852
