**Richard Pocock, 60, labourer, with Sarah 60, Elizabeth 23 needlewoman and grandson Richard Meddick 4
James Davis was a lodger in their house, widower aged 66, and Parish Clerk of Luxborough.
Mary Pocock 20, entered as 'lodger' was in fact Richard's youngest daughter.**

Richard's daughter Ann (see 1841 census) had married Charles Meddick in 1856
