William Mundy, 71, Parish Clerk

Emily, wife, 54

Elizabeth Richards widow, 84

James Davis, nephew, 13

Margaret Cowel, orphan, 6

Emily was Maria Richards' sister married to William Mundy

Elizabeth Richards was the mother of Emily and Maria, hence James' maternal grandmother

It is not known who Elizabeth Cowel was.

James siblings from the 1871 census were:

Louisa, 25, a housemaid in Clifton

Charles, 21, a builders labourer in Clifton

Clara, a domestic cook in Clifton

John cannot be found and had probably died

Emma had died soon after the 1871 census was taken.
