

Death of Annie Elizabeth White, nee Cook

Royal Portsmouth Hospital, Portsmouth. (This has since been demolished)

Annie had been admitted to hospital for a relatively minor illness, but suffered a fall while there, and died as a result of complications. An inquest was held on April 30th, resulting in a verdict of 'accidental death'. . The informant was therefore the coroner, P.D. Childs.

She died on her 89th birthday.
