Act 3 & 4, Geo. V., cap. 27, section 3, enacts that "FORGERY of the following documents, if committed with intent to defraud or deceive, shall be punished with Penal Servitude for any term not exceeding fourteen years:—Any register or record of Births, Baptisms, Marriages, Deaths, which now is, or hereafter may be, by law authorised or required to be kept in the United Kingdom, relating to any Birth, Baptism, Death, Burial, or any part of any such Register, or any Certified Copy of any such Register, or of any part thereof."
